How to Get There

How to get to the Start at Harris Bridge Vineyard (HBV):

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (10 miles from Highways 99W/34/20). Watch for signs for the Harris Bridge Vineyard, turning right at Highway 223, right onto Harris Road, and go 2.5 miles to HBV (the paved road turns to gravel). (Harris Bridge Vineyard, 22937 Harris Road, Philomath, OR 97370)

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (40.5 miles from Highway 101). As you approach Philomath watch for signs for the Harris Bridge Vineyard, turning left at Highway 223, right onto Harris Road, and go 2.5 miles to HBV (the paved road turns to gravel). (Harris Bridge Vineyard, 22937 Harris Road, Philomath, OR 97370)

GPS: Latitude N 44° 34' 44.6" Longitude W 123° 27' 36.6"

How to get to Exchange #1:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (16 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), past Highway 180 (Summit Highway), turn left onto Blodgett Road, turn right at Blodgett School, turn left onto TumTum Road and go one half mile to the exchange at the gate just past Harris Road.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (35 miles from Highway 101). Before Highway 180 (Summit Highway), turn right onto Blodgett Road, turn right at Blodgett School, turn left onto TumTum Road and go one half mile to the exchange at the gate just past Harris Road.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 35' 5.5" Longitude W 123° 31' 35.5"

How to get to Exchange #2:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (16 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), past Highway 180 (Summit Highway), turn left onto Blodgett Road, turn right at Blodgett School, turn left onto TumTum Road and go 4.1 miles on TumTum and watch for the cutout on the right.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (35 miles from Hwy 101). Before Highway 180 (Summit Highway), turn right onto Blodgett Road, turn right at Blodgett School, turn left onto TumTum Road and go 4.1 miles on TumTum and watch for the cutout on the right.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 35' 4.6" Longitude W 123° 31' 35"

How to get to Exchange #3:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (21.5 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. (If you reach Ellmaker State Park, you've gone too far.) Go 0.6 miles and turn left on Shotpouch Road and go 4 miles to the intersection of Shotpouch and Shotpouch Creek Roads.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (29 miles from Hwy 101). Just past Ellmaker State Park, turn right at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. Go 0.6 miles and turn left on Shotpouch Road and go 4 miles to the intersection of Shotpouch and Shotpouch Creek Roads.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 32' 53.1" Longitude W 123° 36' 12.7"

How to get to Exchange #4:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (21.5 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. (If you reach Ellmaker State Park, you've gone too far.) Go 0.6 miles. The exchange is at the intersection of Shotpouch Road and Harlan-Burnt Woods Roads.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (29 miles from Hwy 101). Just past Ellmaker State Park, turn right at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. Go 0.6 miles. The exchange is at the intersection of Shotpouch Road and Harlan-Burnt Woods Roads.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 35' 45.1" Longitude W 123° 37'34.1"

How to get to Exchange #5:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (21.5 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. (If you reach Ellmaker State Park, you've gone too far.) Go 7.7 miles. The exchange is at the pull-over area on the left just before Harlan Road.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (29 miles from Hwy 101). Just past Ellmaker State Park, turn right at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. Go 7.7 miles. The exchange is at the pull-over area on the left just before Harlan Road.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 32' 30.3" Longitude W 123° 41'37.7"

How to get to Exchange #6:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (21.5 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. (If you reach Ellmaker State Park, you've gone too far.) Go 7.8 miles, then turn right onto Harlan Road. Go 5.8 miles to the exchange (just past a camping area on the left).

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (29 miles from Hwy 101). Just past Ellmaker State Park, turn right at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. Go 7.8 miles, then turn right onto Harlan Road. Go 5.8 miles to the exchange (just past a camping area on the left).

GPS: Latitude N 44° 32' 40.8" Longitude W 123° 45'32"

How to get to Exchange #7:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (21.5 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Harlan-Burnt Woods Road. (If you reach Ellmaker State Park, you've gone too far.) Go 7.8 miles, then turn right onto Harlan Road. Go 11.8 miles to the exchange (at the Rusty Bridget).

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (13 miles from Hwy 101), turn right at Elk City Road, left at Harlan Road (near the Elk City County Park), go 9 miles to the exchange (at the Rusty Bridge).

GPS: Latitude N 44° 33' 44" Longitude W 123° 48'41"

How to get to Exchange #8:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (38 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Elk City Road, left at Harlan Road (near the Elk City County Park), go 4.6 miles to the exchange (at Updike Road).

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (13 miles from Hwy 101), turn right at Elk City Road, left at Harlan Road (near the Elk City County Park), go 4.6 miles to the exchange (at Updike Road).

GPS: Latitude N 44° 35' 18" Longitude W 123° 50'20"

How to get to Exchange #9:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20, through Philomath (38 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left at Elk City Road, and go 5 miles.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (13 miles from Hwy 101), turn right at Elk City Road, and go 5 miles.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 37' 13" Longitude W 123° 52'28.3"

How to get to Exchange #10:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20 (44 miles from Highways 99W/34/20). Go south on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn left at NW A Street, left at NW 1st Ave, right on Butler Bridge Road (which becomes Elk City Road), to the Cannon Quarry Boat Ramp (6 miles from the intersection of Hwy 20 and Business Hwy 20).

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (5.5 miles from Highway 101), go southeast on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn right at NW A Street, left at NW 1st Ave, right on Butler Bridge Road (which becomes Elk City Road), to the Cannon Quarry Boat Ramp (5.5 miles from the intersection of Hwy 20 and Business Hwy 20).

GPS: Latitude N 44° 36' 15.6" Longitude W 123° 54'7.5"

How to get to Exchange #11:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20 (44 miles from Highways 99W/34/20). Go south on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn left at NW A Street and go 4 blocks to the train museum.

From Newport: Go east on Highway 20 (5.5 miles from Highway 101), go southeast on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn right at NW A Street and go 4 blocks to the train museum.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 37' 12" Longitude W 123° 56'19"

How to get to Exchange #12:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20 (44 miles from Highways 99W/34/20). Go south on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn left at Yaquina Bay Road and go 3.5 miles to the pull over area.

From Newport: Go east on Yaquina Bay Road to pull over area at Mile Post 9.

GPS: Latitude N 44° 35' 6.66" Longitude W 123° 57'44.9"

How to get to Exchange #13:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20 (44 miles from Highways 99W/34/20). Go south on Business Highway 20 (to Toledo). Turn left at Yaquina Bay Road and go 8.3 miles to Sawyer's Landing (by Richey Road).

From Newport: Go east on Yaquina Bay Road (4.25 miles from Hatfield Drive to Sawyer's Landing (by Richey Road).

GPS: Latitude N 44° 35' 6.66" Longitude W 123° 57'44.9"

How to get to the Finish at the Rogue Brewery:

From Corvallis: Go west on Highway 20 (51 miles from Highways 99W/34/20), turn left (south) on Highway 101 and cross the bridge, take the first right after the bridge and follow OSU Drive, turn right at Ferry Slip Road and park at the Oregon Coast Aquarium lot.

From Newport: Rogue Brewery on the South Beach. Park at the Oregon Coast Aquarium lot.
