WorkSource Orientation: The WorkSource Orientation will provide you with information about the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act and the services available at the WorkSource Center and through community resources and partners. You will also learn about the programs, educational opportunities, tools and resources available to help you in your job search. The workshop is required if you are interested in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Program (WIOA) or need more information about the center.

New To Computers: This is an introductory workshop to computers. Come learn the very basics to computers including hardware, software, and internet use for job search.

Cover Letters: Learn WHY its important to add a cover letter, when to do so and what to include. Writing a cover letter can be a daunting task, let us help you create a fantastic supplement to your resume!

Interview Skills/MOCK Interview: Employment experts teach you how to sell yourself and overcome fear in interviewing. Learn the steps to preparing for an interview and knowing how to answer common and challenging interview questions.
